Site 1, District 3 Within ML-199 SE½ Sec 3 T. 41 N., R. 17 W.
Site 2, District 3 Within ML-197 & 201 SE½ Sec 3 T. 41 N., R. 17 W.
Site 3, District 3 Within ML-199 & 202 SE½ Sec 3 T. 41 N., R. 17 W.
Site 3-A, District 3 Within ML-199 & 202 SE½ Sec 3 T. 41 N., R. 17 W.
Site 4 District 3 Within ML-258 SE½NW2 Sec 2 T. 41 N., R. 17 W.
Site 5 District 3 Within ML-258 & 189 Sec 2 T. 41 N., R. 17 W., and

WHEREAS, The attachment to this Resolution does contain the entire Metes and Bounds descriptions as written within the certificates of Survey, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee mereby approves the above described property be leased to the Mille Lacs Reservation Housing Authority for a period of 25 years plus 25 years, at no cost, and further requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs approve the above mentioned leases.
