A RESOLUTION GRANTING ACCEPTANCE OF THE MILLE LACS
BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS CHILD RESTRAINT PROGRAM
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1983-1984

WHEREAS, The Executive Branch of Tribal Government recognized the need for a child restraint program; and,


WHEREAS, The Executive Branch of Tribal Government through the Women, Infants, and Children Program prepared a proposal under terms of the Indian Highway Safety Project of the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and,

WHEREAS, The purpose of the Women, Infants, and Children Restraint Loan Program is to educate parents on the importance and correct utilization of Infant Car Seat Loan Program to members of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Executive Branch of Tribal Government for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians approves the Child Restraint Loan Program proposal.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, That the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a formal session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislatives being present, held on July 29 1983, at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 for, 0 against, and 0 silent.
