RESOLUTION 06-83

WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee is the governing body of the Mille Lacs Reservation and,

WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee has assumed Land Management by virtue of the Land Ordinance #2 passed by the Tribal Executive Committee on October 22 and 23, 1980, and

WHEREAS, Mille Lacs Resolution No. 21-80 is not definitive in regard to the land description of [REDACTED] and

WHEREAS, the Resolution No. 21-80 is hereby amended to read:


Lot 2, Block All as defined by Map as part of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 28, Twp. 43 N., Rge. 27 W., Map dated March 9,
1982, and

WHEREAS, This lease will be for 25 years plus 25 years at no cost, with an effective date retroactive to November 16, 1979,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee hereby approves a Homesite Lease for [REDACTED] for a period of 25 years plus 25 years at no cost, and the effective date of this lease will be retroactive to November 16, 1979 and the Homesite will be at the above described property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is requested to approve the above described lease.

We do hereby certify that the foregoing Resolution was duly presented and enacted upon by a vot of 3 for, 0 against, 0 silent, at a special meeting of the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee, a quorum being present, held on February 11, 1983, at Vineland Minnesota.
