A RESOLUTION TO PLACE LAND INTO TRUST STATUS FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa has received land in Pine County for homesites, and;
- WHEREAS, this land is used for homesites for members of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the said property is located at: Pine County, Minnesota, the township of Barry, township forty-one (41) north, range twenty (20) west, section thirty-five (35) Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter. Lots 3A, 3B, 3C as established by HUD project No. MN 46-B204-001 and as surveyed by Okerman Surveying Inc., Bemidji, Minnesota, and;
- WHEREAS, should be placed in trust for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians request that the Bureau of Indian Affairs assist the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians in getting said land placed in trust for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa.
- WE HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution No. 67-84 was duly concurred with and adopted at a formal session of the Band Assembly in legislative council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on July 13, 1984 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, and 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this Resolution.
