RESOLUTION NO. 03-84

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE RELINQUISHMENT OF ELIZABETH D. NICHOLS AS A MEMBER OF THE MILLE LACS BAND, MILLE LACS RESERVATION.

- WHEREAS The Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee has screened the following application for relinquishment, and;
- AND WHEREAS Elizabeth D. Nichols has signed a relinquishment form with the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe as he relinquishes and surrenders any and all rights, title and interest that he may have in any undistributed property and assets of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, and;
- AND WHEREAS Information received by the St. Croix Tribal Council states that the Tribal Council will accept Elizabeth D. Nichols for membership providing that relinquishment is certified by the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe;
- AND THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee does determine that this relinquishment is proper and that the interest of the individual has been considered and that he does meet the requirements for membership with the St. Croix Chippewa Indians of Wisconsin, and does approve the granting of the relinquishment for Elizabeth D. Nichols.

WE, DO HEREBY CERTIFY, the foregoing Resolution No. 03-84 was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee, a quorum being present held on Tuesday, the eighteenth day of October in the year of one thousand nine hundred and eighty three, at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 for, 0 against, 0 silent.
