RESOLUTION 26 - 84

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE TERMINATION OF LAND LEASE AGREEMENT FOR [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc., and,

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] have requested that their land lease Agreement be terminated for the following land lease description:

Beginning at a point 1320.29 feet north of the east quarter corner of Section 28, Township 43N, Range 27W, thence North 200 feet, thence west 100 feet, thence south 200 feet, thence east 100 feet to point of beginning.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians terminates this said land lease effective April 3, 1984.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the foregoing Resolution No. 26-84 was duly concurred with and adopted at a formal session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present, held on April 3, 1984 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
