RESOLUTION NO. 21-84


A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION BUSINESS COMMITTEE CHILD AND FAMILY SERVICES PROJECT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1984 - 1985.


- WHEREAS, under Public Law 95-608, Title II Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has financial resources available to provide children, Family and Outreach services on the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the goal of the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee is to provide Counseling, Treatment and related Family Assistance services for Indian children and their families, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee is duly authorized and officially recognized governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians under the Revised Constitution and By-Laws of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984) as amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee hereby approves the application for the Child and Family Services Project under Title II of the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978.

WE, DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution No. 21-84 was duly adopted at a ^{regular} Meeting of the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee, a quorum being present, held on Friday, the 13th day of January in the year one thousand, nine hundred and eighty four, at Vineland Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
