RESOLUTION NO. 30-84

A RESOLUTION DENYING THE ENROLLMENT OF APPLICANTS WHO DO NOT POSSESS THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ENROLLMENT WITH THE MINNESOTA CHIPPEWA TRIBE.

WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee/ Band Assembly has reviewed the following applications for enrollment and;

WHEREAS, [REDACTED]

do not meet the $\frac{1}{4}$ degree requirement for enrollment to the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and;

WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee has reviewed Article II Membership of the Revised Constitution and Bylaws of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee denies the above applications for enrollment because of the failure to comply with requirements found in Article II of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Constitution.
