A RESOLUTION TO CONTINUE POST SECONDARY CARPENTRY PROGRAM A.V.T.I.

- WHEREAS, Staples AVTI receives funds to provide vocational training on the Mille Lacs Reservation and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation wishes to continue Carpentry Program in Post Secondary and,
- WHEREAS, Mille Lacs Reservation has new policies to employ graduates from the Carpentry Program and,
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Education Sub-Committee responds to the educational needs of the Band.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Education Sub-Committee hereby supports the Mille Lacs Reservation to continue their Post Secondary Carpentry Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe Education Sub-Committee requests that Staples AVTI help implement this request.
