RESOLUTION NO. 79 - 84

A RESOLUTION FOR THE GOVERNMENTAL ACCOUNTS OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 1984 WHICH IS IN LIEU OF A FORMAL APPROPRIATIONS STATUTE.

- WHEREAS, Ordinance 02-82, Section & mandates the appropriation of all Band Revenue prior to the commencement of a new fiscal year; and,
- WHEREAS: the Band Assembly has not passed formal appropriations to continue the essential services to the enrolled members of the Mille Lacs Band relative to the General Fund; and:
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians continues to review all necessary financial information in order to ensure the financial integrity of the Band.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby authorizes the continuance of the governmental accounts for a period of thirty days to expire October 31, 1984.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY: that the foregoing Resolution 79-84 was duly concurred with and adopted at a formal session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled: a quorum of legislators being present; held on September 25: 1984 at Vineland: Minnesota by a vote of \_\_2\_FOR: \_\_O\_AGAINST: \_O\_SILENT:
