RESOLUTION 20-84

A RESOLUTION REGARDING A MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS, MINNESOTA AGENCY AND THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION BUSINESS COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee is the governing body of the Mille Lacs Indian Reservation, fully authorized to act in behalf of its members; and,

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs is responsible for the maintenance of certain roads located on the Mille Lacs Indian Reservation, and;


WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Bureau of Indian Affairs cannot economically maintain these roads due to the long distance from their headquarters located at Cass Lake, Minnesota, and;


WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Construction Co. solely owned and operated by the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee has the expertise and equipment to perform the required road maintenance work.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians desires to enter into an agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to perform the required routine maintenance on the designated Indian service routes and requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs prepare the necessary forms to expedite this action as promptly as practical.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution No. 20-84 was duly adopted at a session of the Band Assembly {Reservation Business Committee} in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on November 18, 1983 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 for, 0 against, and 0 silent.
