RESOLUTION 48-84

A RESOLUTION TO DENY CANDIDACY FOR THE OFFICE OF CHAIRMAN FOR THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

- WHEREAS: the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe has announced a general election for the office of Chairman of the six Bands which comprise the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe: and:
- WHEREAS, the popularly elected leadership of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs
 Band of Chippewa Indians did convene this day to review qualifications of those members of the Band who seek constitutional elective office as authorized by the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and the Minnesota Chippewa Tribal Election Ordinance No. 4, III {A}.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the popularly elected leadership does hereby deny candidacy for Floyd Ballinger due to his failure to reside on land held in trust by the United States of America for the benefit of either the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe or the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, in keeping with established Band interpretation of the Constitution and Election Ordinance of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe as applied to the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

The foregoing Resolution 48-84 was duly concurred with and adopted at a formal session of the Reservation Business Committee, a quorum of members being present, held on Thursday, May 10, 1984 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the popularly elected leadership of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians have hereunto caused to have set the signature of the Chairman and the Secretary-Treasurer to be affixed to this Resolution.
