RESOLUTION 75 -84

RESOLUTION RESQUESTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS, FOR A SPECIAL CENSUS.

- WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Reservation was severly under counted in the 1980 Census, and;
- WHEREAS, The Department of Commerce, Census Bureau has provisions to conduct a special census for Indian Reservation Communities, etc., and;
- WHEREAS, The Department of Commerce has estimated the cost for a special census for Mille Lacs, approximate population of 1400 amounting to \$8,245.00 and;
- WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs band has insufficient funds for a special census.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation officially requests from the Bureau of Indian Affairs monetary assistance for the costs of a special census.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary Treasurer of the Mille Lacs Reservation negotiate said agreement with the Bureau of Indian Affairs.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution No. 75-84 was duly concurred with and adopted at a formal session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on August 21, 1984 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to this Resolution.
