## RESOLUTION 54-84

A RESOLUTION TO CONTRACT FISCAL YEAR 1984 TRIBAL COURT FUNDS FROM THE MINNESOTA CHIPPEWA TRIBE.

- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Chippewa Tribal Executive Committee did approve a budget request for funds in the category of Tribal Courts, and:
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs did announce its decision to contract these funds to the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, and:
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Agency of the Bureau of Indian Affairs did notify the Mille Lacs Band that their share of these funds is fifteen thousand dollars {\$15,000}.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby requests that tribal court funds allocated to Mille Lacs be sub-contracted from the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe.
- WE, DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted at a legal session of the Band Assembly {Reservation Business Committee}, in legislative council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on figure 1984 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of FOR, FOR, SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, were the Band Assembly {Reservation Business Committee} hereunto caused to have set the hand of the Speaker of the Assembly {Secretary-Treasurer} to be affixed to this Resolution.
