RESOLUTION 53-84

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH AUTHORITY FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF CANDIDATES.

- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe has announced a general election for the offices of Chairman and District I Representative of the six Bands which comprise the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, and;
- WHEREAS, the popularly elected leadership of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians did convene this day to review notices of candidacy to determine those Band members who meet standards established in the Constitution and Election Ordinance No. 4 for certification as candidates, and;
- WHEREAS: the Reservation Business Committee's of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe each certify the candidacy of Band members who seek Constitutional office in each Band's government.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the popularly elected leadership of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby determines that the Reservation Business Committee has the sole and final authority to certify candidates for Constitutional office:

The foregoing Resolution 52-84 was duly concurred with and adopted at a formal session of the Reservation Business Committee, a quorum of members being present, held on Thursday, May 10, 1984 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of  $\_3$  FOR,  $\_0$  AGAINST,  $\_0$  SILENT.
