RESOLUTION NO. 74-84

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LAND USE PERMIT TO ESTABLISH A NEW BINGO FACILITY.

- WHEREAS, the Bingo Commission wishes to establish a new Bingo facility on the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the said property is held in trust for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, the establishment would greatly benefit the economic condition of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and,
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows:

Mille Lacs County
Kathio Twp-North Section 2A T43N R27W
Sublot D That portion described as
19.30 acres less the NW 1/4, NW 1/4, SW 1/4

- WHEREAS, the land use permit will be for a period of 10 years with an option to genew; and
- WHEREAS, the development of the new facility will keep and maintain environmental standards of the Mille Lacs Reservation to keep in compliance with land use permit.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly authorizes a land use permit for the establishment of a Bingo facility for a period of 10 years with an option to renew.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution 74-84 was duly concurred with and adopted at a formal session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present held on August 21, 1984 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR 0 AGAINST 0 SILENT.
