RESOLUTION 17-84 B

AN ADDENDUM TO CONTINUANCE RESOLUTION 17-84 FOR THE PROGRAM-MATIC, CORPORATE AND GOVERNMENTAL ACCOUNT STRUCTURE FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1983, WHICH IS IN LIEU OF A FORMAL APPROPRIATIONS STATUTE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance D2-B2, Section & mandates the appropriation of all Band Revenue prior to the commencement of a new fiscal year; and,

WHEREAS: the Band Assembly has not passed formal appropriations to continue the essential services to the enrolled members of the Mille Lacs Band: and:

WHEREAS, the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians continues to review all necessary financial information in order to ensure the financial integrity of the Band.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby authorizes the continuance of the following programs for a period of fifteen {15} days to expire midnight November 30, 1983, said expenditures shall not exceed the amounts listed:

MEED - Nay-Ah-Shing School - 2-07b MEED - Social Nutrition - 5-755 MEED - Food Commodity - 4-301 MEED - b38 contract - 1-374 Housing Improvement Program - 40-000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should any effected employee be part-time, a furlough is in order for only that portion of total time. The Corporate structure of the Band is hereby authorized to continue operation during this period.
