RESOLUTION 10-83

## A RESOLUTION GRANTING LAND LEASE TO

WHEREAS: wishes the lease of a lot on Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a home site; and:

WHEREAS: tribal land leases are needed for the purpose of a home site on tribal land from the Mille Lacs Reservation; and:

WHEREAS, said land is described as: commencing at the southwest corner of said lot &, thence north &90 29' 14" east, bearing assumed, along the south line of said lot & a distance of 333.91 feet; thence north Do 13' 42" east a distance of 95.41 feet; thence north 640 59' 39" east a distance of 34& feet to the point of beginning of the land to be described; thence continue north 640 59' 39" east a distance of 200.00 feet; thence north 650 00' 21" west a distance of 230.00 feet; thence south 640 59' 39" west a distance of 200.00 feet; thence south 650 00' 21" east a distance of 230.00 feet to the point of beginning and there terminating. Containing 1.06 acres more or less.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly approve said lease for 25 years, plus 25 years renewal.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY: that the foregoing Resolution No. 10-84 was duly conccurred with and adopted at a formal session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled: a quorum of legislatures being present: held on October 19: 1983 at Vineland: Minnesota by a vote of 3 for: 0 against; and 0 silent.
