RESOLUTION NO. 71-84

A RESOLUTION TO APPLY TO THE GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON RURAL DEVELOPMENT TO FUND THE AH-SHU-MOOG PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Rural Development has funds to help development of rural economic demonstration projects, and;


WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is in need of economic development on the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, Ah-Shu-Moog Native Products needs funding to help to further development of the project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians act as sponsoring agency and grantee for the project titled Ah-Shu-Moog to be conducted by the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians during the period from October 1, 1984 through September 30, 1985. AJ Nickaboine is hereby authorized to apply to the Governor's Council on Rural Development for funding of this project and execute such agreements as are necessary to implement the project on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution 71-84 was duly adopted at a session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on August 6, 1984 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
