RESOLUTION NO. 11-85

A continuance Resolution for the governmental account for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians for the month of December 1984. Which is in lieu of a formal appropriations statute

WHEREAS, Ordinance 02-82, Section 8, mandates the appropriation of all Band Revenue prior to the commencement of a new fiscal year; and,

WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has not passed formal appropriations to continue to enrolled members of the Mille Lacs Band relative to the General Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians continue to review all necessary financial information in order to ensure the financial integrity of the Band.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby authorize the continuance of the governmental account for a period of thirty days to expire on December 31, 1984 said expenditure shall not exceed the amounts listed.
