RESOLUTION NO. 03-32-85

A RESOLUTION APPROVING CONSOLIDATED HOUSING INVENTORY DONE FOR THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS AS IT APPLIES TO THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has implemented a consolidated housing inventory, and;
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs is requiring that a consolidated housing inventory be done, and;
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has approved a 93-638 Contract for Home Improvement Program on the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the consolidated housing inventory was done for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians as of May, 1985, and;
- WHEREAS, the consolidated housing inventory established the following needs for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians,
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| a. Total number of existing housing units | - 196 |
| b. Number of existing HUD units | - 39 |
| c. Number of standard condition housing units | 46 |
| d. Number of substandard condition | 111 |
| e. Number of units needing renovation | 78 |
| f. Number of housing units needed replacement | 33 |
| g. Families needing housing | 57 |
| h. Total new housing units required | 90 |

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby concurs with the consolidated housing inventory done on Mille Lacs Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said consolidated housing inventory results be submitted to the Bureau of Indian Affairs so as to meet the requirement of the home improvement program.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution 32-85 was duly concurred with and adopted at a found session of the Band Assembly in Legislative being present held on May 15, 1985 at Vineland, Minnesota by vote of 3 for, 0 against, 0 silent.
