Resolution 02-25-85

A RESOLUTION OF TRIBAL GOVERNMENT IN SUPPORT OF THE NON-REMOVABLE AND THE REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS WITH INTERESTS IN THE WHITE EARTH LAND CLAIMS.

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Chippewa Tribal Executive Committee adopted Resolution No. 94-85 in support of the heirs of the Treaty of 1867, Mississippi Treaty, and;

WHEREAS: The Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians (Removable and Non-Removable) have interests on the land issues on the White Earth Reservation, and;

WHEREAS: The Congress of the United States has proposed legislation of settlement in monetary value for such land claims, and;

WHEREAS: The Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians believe that this legislation is detrimental to the heirs of the Treaty of 1867 and all other treaties and land claims.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Tribal Government go on record opposing any legislation past or present that the Band feels is detrimental to the persons with interests in the White Earth Land Issue.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman (Chief Executive) and the Secretary/Treasurer (Speaker of the Assembly) are hereby authorized to oppose any or all legislation the Band feels is detrimental to the Mille Lacs enrollees on the White Earth Land Issues be it in the Senate, Congress or the State of Minnesota Legislature.

BE IT FUTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution 02-25-85 be mailed to the appropriate governmental agencies, the Senate, Congress and the State legislature

WE DO HEREBLY CERTIFY THAT, the foregoing Resolution 02-25-85 was duly adopted in legal session of the Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) in legislative council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on May 2nd, 1985 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of  
3 FOR 0 AGAINST 0 SILENT.
