RESOLUTION 03-35-85

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PROPOSAL REQUESTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE ADMINISTRATION FOR NATIVE AMERICANS (ANA), BY THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

- the Office of Human Development Services has available program WHEREAS. funds to assist tribal governments in promoting their economic and social self-sufficiency through Public Law 93-644, Native American Public Act of 1974, as amended, under section 803, and;
- WHEREAS. the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has needs that can not be met with other resources or funds, and;
- the securing of additional funds would greatly increase the WHEREAS. tribal government in reaching a goal of economic and social self-sufficiency, and;
- WHEREAS. without the financial assistance of the Administration for Native Americans (ANA), the tribal government will not be able to reach the goal of economic and social self-sufficiency, and;
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians do hereby approve and authorize the submission of a proposal to the office of Health and Human Development Services for financial assistance under the provisions of Public Law 93-644, Native American Programs Act of 1974 (as amended) under Section 803.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians will aspire to attain the goals presented in the aforementioned proposal to the best of their ability with or without the financial assistance of ANA, in order to realize it's future development of social and economic self-sufficiency.
- WE, the Administrative Policy Board, hereunto recommend to have set the hand of the Chief Executive to this resolution.
