RESOLUTION NO. 108-85

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 66-84, 70-84 LAND LEASE AGREEMENT FOR [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite: and,

WHEREAS, tribal land leases are needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land from the Mille Lacs Reservation: and,

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: W $\frac{1}{2}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Lot 9, T 41 N. Range 20 W, Pine County.

WHEREAS the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years, effective August 8, 1984, for the purpose of financing this home.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly approves a lease to be issued to [REDACTED] for the period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective August 8, 1984 at the rate of \$1.00 per term.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution 10-85 was duly concurred with and adopted a formal session of Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on December 11, 1984 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
