RESOLUTION 03-47-85

A continuing resolution for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians Public Law 93-638 Tribal Government Project.

- WHEREAS: The Bureau of Indian Affairs has a responsibility to assist tribal government so as to further develop their self-determination efforts through Public Law 93-638, Indian Self-Determination Act, and;
- WHEREAS: the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has an interest in improving and strengthening its governmental structure, and;
- WHEREAS: the Bureau of Indian Affairs has funds to assist the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians in improving and strengthening its government, and;
- WHEREAS: the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does not have the necessary funds to improve and strengthen its governmental structure.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby approve and adopt this continuing resolution for Public Law 93-638 Tribal Government Project so as to improve and strengthen the government of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Executive or his designee develop and implement grants to improve and strengthen the Band's government.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution 03-47-85 was duly concurred with and adopted at a session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on the third day of, September, 1985 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 6 SILENT.
