RESOLUTION NO. 2-18-85 6

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PROPOSAL REQUESTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDITED TO TOA ZMARQORQ NATIVE AND TO TOA ZMARQORQ NATIVE AND TO TOA ZMARQORQ NATIVE AND TO TOA ZNA JANA SALVEN AND TOA ZMARQORQ NATIVE AND TOA ZMARQORQ N

- WHEREAS: the Office of Human Development Services has available program funds to assist tribal governments in promoting their economic and social self-sufficiency through Public Law 93-644. Native American Public Act of 1974; as amended; under Section 803; and;
- WHEREAS: the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians have initiated Senate Bill 354 in the United States Senate with the intent of separating the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians from the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and retroceding Public Law 280: among other things: and:
- WHEREAS, with enactment of Senate Bill 354 the Mille Lacs Federation of Chippewar today know as the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, would take appropriate action to adopt a Constitution and Bylaws, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians terminated the Tax Agreements with the State of Minnesota.
- NOW: THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians do hereby approve and authorize the submission of a proposal to the Office of Health and Human Development Services for financial assistance under the provisions of Public Law 93-944. Native American Programs Act of 1974 {as amended} under Section 803.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians will aspire to attain the goals presented in the afore mentioned proposal to the best of their ability with or without the financial assistance of ANA, in order to realize it's future development of social and economic self-sufficiency.
- WE: the Administration Policy Board: hereunto recommend to have set the hand of the Chief Executive to this resolution.
