RESOLUTION 03-55-85

A RESOLUTION GRANTING EASEMENT ACROSS LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO THE MILLE LACS ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTRICAL SERVICES.

- WHEREAS, Mille Lacs Electric is desirous of obtaining an easement for installing electricity for intersection lights located at Vineland, Minnesota on HWY 169, and;
- WHEREAS, Band Statute 1094-MLC-47, designates rules and regulations governing the issuance of easements across lands under the jurisdiction of the Band, and;
- WHEREAS, pursuant to his statutory authority, the Commissioner of Natural Resources has reviewed the request of the Mille Lacs Electric Company and does hereby recommend that the Chief Executive approve said easement request.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the request for an easement across land herein described as: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of TWP 43 N Range 27 W Section 28 North Kathio. The easement would be 20 feet in width starting at a point 33 feet south of the intersection of HWY 169 and west side road as defined by the Vineland Hills addition, Registration No. 12266, and running west along a line 33 feet south of the center line of west side road a distance of 780 feet.

is hereby conferred and the United States Department of Interior-Bureau of Indian Affairs is requested to officially record said easement as a valid easement across lands herein described. Said easement subject to termination for cause pursuant to the easement laws of the Band is granted for a period of one year automatically renewable on the annual effective date of each successive calendar year unless terminated within thirty days prior notice to the holder. Said easement is also subject to provisions of the environmental protection laws of the United States of America and the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians. Upon the payment of said easement fee said resolution shall be forwarded for official reading.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, Don Williams, Commissioner of Natural Resources fo hereunto recommend the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
