RESOLUTION 03-41-85

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDS FROM  
THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS


- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Tribal Government are duly elected to govern the Band; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Tribal Government from time to time need more educational workshops to promote a more effective government; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band had requested funds from the Bureau of Indian Affairs to attend a Tribal Government workshop; and,
- WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs authorized expenditures for a workshop from the Tribal Government Program; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Tribal Government Program has no monies from the present program to obscure these costs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Bureau of Indian Affairs supplement the grant from carry-over funds within the FY 1985 budget ending September 30, 1985 totalling \$5,000 for expenses.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Commissioner of Natural Resources modify and change the scope of work in the Tribal Government Grant.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly, in Legislative council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on the sixth day of August, 1985 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
