## Legislative Branch of Tribal Government

RESOLUTION NO. 14-85

A continuance Resolution for the governmental account for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians for the month of January, 1985. Which is in lieu of a formal appropriations statute.

- WHEREAS, Ordinance 02-82, Section 8, mandates the appropriation of all Band Revenue prior to the commencement of a new fiscal year; and,
- WHEREAS, The Band Assembly has not passed formal appropriations to continue the essential services to the enrolled members of the Mille Lacs Band; and,
- WHEREAS, The Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians continues to review all necessary financial information in order to ensure the financial integrity of the Band.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby authorize the continuance of the governmental account for a period of thirty days to expire January 31, 1985, said expenditure shall not exceed the amounts listed:

Fringe	1,500.00
Travel	1,000.00
Postage	195.35
Supplies	7.65
Other	1,000.00
Road Maintenance	1,000.00
Operation Maintenance	2,000.00
