RESOLUTION NO. 02-28-85

A Resolution in support of any application for grant support submitted to the Otto Bremer Foundation.

WHEREAS: Representatives of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians have been serving on a joint task with the Representatives of the Minnesota Historical Society, and;

WHEREAS: the task force has developed a concept plan for commercial development, and;

WHEREAS: the next phase of a joint cultural and commercial development plan is to prepare a preliminary site plan and business plan, and;

WHEREAS: the Band is in need of additional financial support to complete its planning activities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians support a proposal to the Otto Bremer Foundation requesting \$20,000.00 of grant monies to support the next phase of joint planning for the development of cultural and commercial facilities.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution 02-28-85 was duly concurred and adopted at a formal session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on May 2nd, 1985 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR 0 AGAINST 0 SILENT.
