## RESOLUTION NO. 15-85

A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING USE OF NATURAL RESOURCE GRANT, CONSERVATION SPECIAL ACCOUNT, HOME IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND COMMUNITY BLOCK GRANT ADMINISTRATION.

- WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Band of Chippewas has an extreme need for economic development on the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the coordination of different programs will greatly improve the condition on the Mille Lacs Reservation; and,
- WHEREAS, the Community Development Grant Administration requires a percentage of matching funds; and,
- WHEREAS, the following funds are available to be coordinated so as to improve housing conditions;

93,000.00	Mille Lacs Reservation HIP funds
3,000.00	Natural Resource Grant
30,000.00	Yakima Indian Nation
1,000.00	Conservation Special Account
96,338.00	Community Block Grant Adiministration "CBGA"

- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians authorize the above amounts of monies be expended on the establishment of a domestic elk herd on the Mille Lacs Reservation.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution was duly adopted at a session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled a quorum of legislators being present, held on December 28, 1984 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR 0 AGAINST 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of the Assemby to be affixed to this resolution
