RESOLUTION 03-33-86

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE APPROVAL FROM THE MILLE LACS BAND ASSEMBLY TO WAIVE THE 4% VENDING MACHINE TAX FOR THE NAY AH SHING SCHOOL STUDENT FUND RAISER.

- the Commissioner of Finance is authorized and empowered WHEREAS. pursuant to Band Statute 1085-MLC-30/37 to enforce all provisions of these chapters, and;
- the Commissioner of Finance hereby requests authorization WHEREAS. to waive the 4% vending machine tax for the Nay Ah Shing Student Fund Raiser, effective December 10, 1985. The students use these funds for various activities, including bowling, field trips, etc.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, I, Harry D. Simons, do hereby request the waiver on the 4% vending machine tax on the Nay Ah Shing Student fund raiser.
