A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO

- WHEREAS: wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite; and;
- WHEREAS. Tribal land leases are needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land for the Mille Lacs Reservation. and:
- WHEREAS: said land is described as follows: that sublot described as the property on the West side of County Highway no. 14 beginning at the intersection County Highway no. 14 and the north line of the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 22 TWP 50 N· R· 23 W·: hence west along said line a distance of 200 ft. hence north 200 ft. hence east 200 ft. and south 200 ft. to point of beginning.
- WHEREAS: the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective July 8, 1986 for the purpose of financing this home.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective July 8, 1986 at the rate of \$1.00 per term.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT FUTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that lease will utilize the provisions of the resolution within 12 months, if provisions are not met, lease will than revert back to the Band.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the forgoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on July8, 1986 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
