RESOLUTION 03-04-86

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO [REDACTED]

- WHEREAS, [REDACTED] wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite, and;
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land for the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Spalding Township 47 N R 23 W, Section 21 NE $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ North of MSSM Railroad right-of-way. That subplot identified as Site 15 by Phillip S. Blott.
- WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective October 24, 1985 for the purpose of financing this home.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to [REDACTED] for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective October 24, 1985 at the rate of \$ 1.00 per term.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that leasee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within 12 months, if provisions are not met, lease will than revert back to the Band.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on October 24, 1985 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
