## RESOLUTION 05-88-86

## A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ORAL HISTORY PROJECT.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the goal of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is to document the Indian culture and to provide all necessary research to record the cultural and oral history, and;
- WHEREAS, the National Endowment of the Humanities has the necessary funds available to implement the project, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is desirous in obtaining funding for the oral history project.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians prepare an application and proposal to fund this worthwhile project.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on September 25, 1986 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
