RESOLUTION 03- 05-86

A RESOLUTION GRANTING EASEMENT ACROSS LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS TO THE PINE COUNTY COOP FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTRICAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, Pine County Coop (Braton G. Churchill) is desirous of obtaining a (20) foot easement for the use on the premises in connection with land leases, and;

WHEREAS, Band Statute 1094-MLC-47, designates rules and regulations govern issuance of easements across lands under the jurisdiction of the

WHEREAS, pursuant to his statutory authority, the Commissioner of Natural has reviewed the request of the Pine County Coop and does hereby that the Chief Executive approve said easement request.

is hereby conferred and the United States Department of Interior of Indian Affairs is requested to officially record said easement easement across the land herein described. Said easement subject tion for cause pursuant to the easement laws of the Band is grant period of one (1) year automatically renewable on the annual effe of each successive calendar year unless terminated within thirty prior notice to the holder. Said easement is also subject to prothe environmental protection laws of the United States of America Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians. Upon the paymeasement fee said resolution shall be forwarded for official reachests.
