RESOLUTION 04-43-86

A RESOLUTION BY THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIAN APPROVING THE VOLUNTEERS IN SERVICE TO AMERICA (VISTA) FUNDED THROUGH ACTION FOR FISCAL YEAR 1986.

- WHEREAS, the Volunteers In Service to America (VISTA) through ACTION has financial resources available to provide community service on the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the goal of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is to provide community service to the enrolled members of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly authorized and officially recognized governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians under the Revised Constitution and by-laws of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Statement) as amended.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves the application for the Volunteers &n Service to America (VISTA) through ACTION.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution.
