RESOLUTION 03-37-86

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE AUTHORIZATION TO REQUEST ASSISTANCE FROM ATTORNEY'S UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

- WHEREAS, Ordinance 02-82, Section 8 mandates the appropriation of all Band Revenue prior to the commencment of a new fiscal year, and;
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has authorized an attorneys contract for fiscal year 1986 with the attorney firm of Ziontz, Pirtle, Morisset, Ernstoff & Chestnut, and;
- WHEREAS, the authorization to expend funds under this Attorneys contract shall be limited to the appropriation of funds authorized in the appropriation process, and;
- WHEREAS, the using, consulting, corresponding and communication with said Attorney firm, without approved resolution, shall not be the responsibility of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that anyone using consulting, corresponding and communicating with the attorney firm of Ziontz, Pirtle, Morisset, Ernstoff & Chestnut without the proper resolution approved by the Band Assembly shall be personally liable for all cost concurred in transaction with said Attorney firm.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a session of the Band Assembly in Legilative council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on December 30, 1985 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the hand of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution.
