RESOLUTION 04-42-86 A

A RESOLUTION GRANTING APPROPRIATION FROM THE GENERAL SALES ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL OPERATING ACCOUNT FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY, 1986 WHICH IS IN LIEU OF A FORMAL APPROPRIATIONS STATUTE.

- WHEREAS, Ordinance 02-82, Section8 mandates the appropriation of all Band Revenue prior to commencement of a new fiscal year, and;
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly has not passed formal appropriations to continue the essential services to the enrolled members of the Mille Lacs Band, and;
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians continues to review all necessary financial information in orde to insure the financial integrity of the Band.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band Assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians herby authorizes an amount not to exceed \$6,116.96 for personnel, fringe and travel from the General Sales Account to the General Operating Account for January, 1986.
- WE DO HERBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Special Revenue Resolution 04-42-86A was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a Quorum of legislators being present, held on February 13, 1986 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the hand of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution.
