## RESOLUTION D5-72-AL

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING APPROVAL FOR THE PROGRAM EXPANSION OF GRADES KINDERGARTEN TO SIXTH IN THE NAY AH SHING SCHOOL.

- WHEREAS: Nay Ah Shing is an Indian controlled school under the Indians Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act of 1975; and:
- WHEREAS: Nay Ah Shing School's goal is to provide education determined by the local community that meets the special educational and cultural needs of its children; and:
- WHEREAS, the Consolidated Nay Ah Shing School Board has given its' approval to expand its' educational program to include grades kindergarten through sixth.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that Lindy S. Grell: Commissioner of Education for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians be authorized to act on behalf of the Nay Ah Shing School in executing and negotiating all pertinent documents pertaining to this expansion.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board do hereunto recommend the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
