A RESOLUTION TO DENY CANDIDACY FOR THE OFFICE OF SECRETARY/TREASURER FOR THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe has announced a general election for WHEREAS, the office of Secretary/Treasurer of the six Bands which comprise the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, and;

the popularily elected leadership of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs WHEREAS, Band of Chippewa Indians did convene this day to review qualifications of those members of the Band who seek constitutional elective office as authorized by the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and the Minnesota Chippewa Tribal Election Ordinance No. 41 III {A}.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the popularily elected leadership does hereby diny candidacy for Mush Koub due to his failure to reside on land held in trust by the United States of America for the benefit of either the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe or the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, in keeping with established Band interpretation of the Constitution and Election Ordinance of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe as applied to the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

> The foregoing Resolution 04-59-86 was duly concurred with and adopted at a formal session of the Joint Session (Reservation Business Committee} a quorum of members being present, held on Thursday, May 8, 1986 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, O SILENT.
