## RESOLUTION 04-66 -86

## A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO

WHEREAS.	wishes the lease of a lot on the MIlle Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite, and:
WHEREAS 7	Tribal land leases are needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land for the Mille Lacs Reservation, and:

- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Vineland Hills, Part of the North half of the NE 1/4 of section 28. Township 43 N. Range 27 West. That sublot identified as Block L, Sublot 22.
- WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective June 12, 1986 for the purpose of financing this home.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves for a period of 25 years plus a lease to be issued to for a period of 25 years p 25 years renewal effective June 12, 1986 at the rate of \$1.00 per term.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that leasee will utilize the provisions of the resolution within 12 months, if provisions are not met, lease will than revert back to the Band.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the forgoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held 1986 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, on June 12-O AGAINST, O SILENT.
