RESOLUTION 04-38-86

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO

- WHEREAS, wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of ahomesite, and;
- WHEREAS, tribal land leases are needed for the purpose of a homesite on tribal land for the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: NE ¼, NW ¼ Section 17, Township 47 N, Range 23 West of Aitken County. Lot 9 as defined by the General Development Plan Mille Lacs Housing Site, Bureau of Indian Affairs C.A. Hammond July 24, 1969, and;
- WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective February 13, 1986 for the purpose of financing this home.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective February 13, 1986 at the rate of \$ 1.00 per term.
- BE IT FURTHER & FINALLY RESOLVED, that leasee will utilize the provisions of this resolution within twelve (12) months, if provisions are not met, lease will than revert back to the Band.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution 04-38-86 was duly concurred with adopted at a session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on February 13, 1986 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution.
