RESOLUTION 04-41-86

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS CHILD AND FAMILY SERVICES PROJECT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1986.

- WHEREAS, under Public Law 95-608, Title II Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has financial resources available to provide children, Family and Outreach services on the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, the goal of the Band Assembly (Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee) is to provide Counseling, Treatment and related family assistance services for Indian children and their families, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly authorized and officially recognized governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians under the Revised Constitution and By-laws of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984) as amended.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approved the application for the Child and Family Services Project under Title II of the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution.
