RESOLUTION 05-76-86

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING A FORCE ACCOUNT ON BEHALF OF THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION HOUSING AUTHORITY.

ON BEHALF OF THE MILLE LACS HOUSING AUTHORITY, THE BAND ASSEMBLY ENACTS THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly is a sovereignty possessed of the jurisdiction and authority to exercise regulatory control within the boundaries of the Mille Lacs Reservation, and;
- WHEREAS, it is the obligation of the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly under the treaty of 1854 and Public Law 93-638, the Indian Self-Determination Act, to assume responsibility of self government, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation has a definite need for the completion of project MN 204-2, and;
- whereas, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly feels that be a cause of the problems that occurred during the first phase of this project, the method of force account would be the best possible manner to complete Project MN 204-2, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly will agree to cover any cost in excess of the HUD approved development cost including contingencies not to exceed \$ 250,000.00
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly requests HUD Office of Indian Programs to approve the force account for completion of Project MN 204-2.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in legislative council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present, held on July 24, 1986 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of FOR, 3 AGAINST, SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this resolution.
