RESOLUTION 03 -2 26 - 86

A RESOLUTION GRANTING APPROPRIATION FROM THE GENERAL SALES ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL OPERATENG ACCOUNT FOR THE MILLE LACS BNAD OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1985, WHICH IS IN LIEU OF A FORMAL APPROPRIATIONS STATUTE.

STORES.

- WHEREAS, Ordinance 02-82, Section 8 mandates the appropriation of all Band Revenue prior to the commencement of a new fiscal year, and:
- WHEREAS, THE Band Assembly has not passed formal appropriations to continue the essential services to the enrolled members of the Mille Lacs Band, and:
- WHEREAS, the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians continues to review all necessary financial information in order to ensure the financial integrity of the Band.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Band assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians herby authorizes an amount not to exceed \$1,010.00 for personnel, fringe and travel from the Petroleum Sales Account to the General Operating Account for a period of 30 days to expire on November 30, 1985.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing special Revenue Resolution 03-22-86 was duly concurred with and adopted at a session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on November 21, 1985 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the speaker of assembly to be affixed to this resolution.
