A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE TERMINATION OF LAND  
LEASE AGREEMENT FOR [REDACTED]

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc, and;
- WHEREAS, [REDACTED] has requested that her land lease agreement be terminated for the following land lease description:

North 200 feet of the East 100 feet of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the  
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 28, Township 43 North, Range 27 West.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians terminates this land lease agreement effective August 4, 1987

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution 02-02-51-87 was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present held on August 4, 1987 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 FOR 0 AGAINST 0 SILENT.
