RESOLUTION 02-02-57-87

A RESOLUTION GRANTING A LAND LEASE TO [REDACTED]

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly elected governing body for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is responsible for all land lease agreements, etc; and,

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] wishes the lease of a lot on the Mille Lacs Reservation for the purpose of a homesite; and,

WHEREAS, said land is described as follows: Lot 4 of Block 1 of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Vineland Hills addition to Section 28T, 43N, R27W of Mille Lacs County. Starting at a point 300 ft. north of the northwest corner of Lot 1 Block 3 of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28 T 43 N R 27 W and consisting of a Lot 100' X 200' with 100' of frontage on West side of road.


WHEREAS, the lease will have to be for a period of 25 years plus 25 years effective August 18, 1987 for the purpose of a homesite.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly hereby approves a lease to be issued to [REDACTED] for a period of 25 years plus 25 years renewal effective August 18, 1987 at the rate of \$ 1.00 per term.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that lessee will utilize the provisions of this Resolution within 12 months, if provisions are not met, lease will then revert back to the Band.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing Resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a regular session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of Legislators being present, held on August 18, 1987 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 2 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Band Assembly hereunto cause to have set the signature of the Speaker of Assembly to be affixed to this Resolution.
