RESOLUTION 02-01-28-87

A RESOLUTION TO DENY CANDIDACY FOR THE OFFICE OF DISTRICT I REPRESENTATIVE FOR THE NON-REMOVABLE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe has announced a general special election for the office of District I Representative of the six Bands which comprise the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, and;


WHEREAS, the popularly elected leadership of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians did convene this day to review qualifications of those members of the Band who seek constitutional elective office as authorized by the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and the Minnesota Chippewa Tribal Election Ordinance No. 4, III (A).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the popularly elected leadership does hereby deny candidacy for Herbert Weyaus due to his failure to reside on land held in trust by the United States of America for the benefit of either the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe or the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, in keeping with established Band interpretation of the Constitution and Election Ordinance of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe as applied to the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution 02-01-28-87 was duly concurred with and adopted at a Joint Session of the Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislators being present held on the 2nd day of March, 1987 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 4 FOR, 0 AGAINST, 0 SILENT.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the popularly elected leadership of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians have hereunto caused to have set the signatures of the Chief Executive and the Acting Secretary/Treasurer to be affixed to this resolution.
