RESOLUTION 02-04-65-88

A RESOLUTION BY THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A PROPOSAL FOR FUNDING OF THE FOOD DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 1989.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) is the duly governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, fully authorized to act on behalf of its members, and;
- WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is a need to assist low income families residing on the Mille Lacs Reservation with nutritional services, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is interested in applying for funds for the Food Distribution Program for Fiscal Year 1989 to assist those eligible low-income households.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band Assembly (Reservation Business Committee) hereby approves and requests the continued funding of the Food Distribution Program for Fiscal Year 1989.
- IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we, the Administrative Policy Board hereunto recommend the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution and forwarded to the Band Assembly for concurrence.
